The Bismarck-class battleships were 251 m (823 ft 6 in) long overall and 241.60 m (792 ft 8 in) long at the waterline. The ships had a beam of 36 m (118 ft 1 in), and a designed draft of 9.30 m (30 ft 6 in); the draft at standard displacement was 8.63 m (28 ft 4 in), and 9.90 m (32 ft 6 in) at a full load.

The H class was a series of battleship designs for Nazi Germany's Kriegsmarine, which were intended to fulfill the requirements of Plan Z in the late 1930s and early 1940s. The first variation, "H-39," called for six ships to be built, essentially as enlarged Bismarck -class battleships with 40.6 cm (16.0 in) guns and diesel propulsion.

The Bismarck Class. As we have seen, the battleships of the Bismarck Class were the product of a warship development that had begun with the construction of the so-called "pocket battleships" (Panzerschiffe) of the Deutschland Class in the late 20's and early 30's under the restrictions of the Treaty of Versailles.

Bismarck Design

Over the course of her career, Bismarck had to face four battleships, four cruisers, two carriers and eight destroyers (not counting the ships that were en route to engage her). Tirpitz was attacked eight times by British aircraft - five times by carrier aircraft and three by Lancasters.
