of modern Bengali literature. Under the influence of the west the Bengali writers have enriched their literature. During the 17 th century the volume of Bengali literature was tedious, devoid of substance, variety and virility. English literature has given a new dimension to Bengali literature.

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Bengali literature (Bengali: [বঙ্গ সাহিত্য](#), Bangla Sahityô) denotes the body of writings in the Bengali language. The earliest extant work in Bengali literature is the Charyapada, a collection of Buddhist mystic songs dating back to the 10th and 11th centuries. Thereafter, the timeline of Bengali literature is divided into two periods – medieval (1360-1800) and modern (after 1800).

One of the prominent figures of the Bengali literature in the early sixteenth century was the Vedic spiritual leader Chaitanya Mahaprabhu, who lived from 1486 to 1534. He was devoted adherent of Krishna bhakti and founded Gaudiya Vaishnavism , which was a religious movement based on the belief that Sri Krishna is the only God.

This is one reason that the earliest specimens of Bengali language and literature, the Charyapadas (Buddhist mystic songs), are also claimed by speakers of Oriya and Assamese as their own. The Bengali linguists Suniti Kumar Chatterji and Sukumar Sen suggested that Bengali had its origin in the 10th century ce , deriving from Magahi Prakrit (a spoken language) through Magahi Apabhramsha (its written counterpart).
