Bengali literature (Bengali: [][][][] Bangla Sahityô) denotes the body of writings in the Bengali language. The earliest extant work in Bengali literature is the Charyapada, a collection of Buddhist mystic songs dating back to the 10th and 11th centuries. Thereafter, the timeline of Bengali literature is divided into two periods — medieval (1360-1800) and modern (after 1800).

One of the prominent figures of the Bengali literature in the early sixteenth century was the Vedic spiritual leader Chaitanya Mahaprabhu, who lived from 1486 to 1534.
