What are 'Chapter 8 compliant' markings? Compliance with these specifications is recommended for use on all types of highway particularly high speed roads. All vehicles stopping on the highway for works purposes or inspections shall: be equipped with high visibility rear markings ; be of a conspicuous colour (e.g. yellow or white).

## Where To Download Chapter 8 Road Markings

Reference should be made to Chapter 8 for guidance on the use of warning signs when road works result in the temporary absence of markings.  
SITING OF STOP AND GIVE WAY SIGNS 3.16 The signs should be sited as close as possible to their corresponding marking, but not in such a position as to impair visibility along the major road.
