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Ford Focus Engine Temperature In

The Ford Focus uses a belt driven water pump to circulate coolant -- a 50/50 mix of water and antifreeze -- through the engine. As the coolant moves through the engine it absorbs heat generated by the combustion process. Heat coolant is released to the air in the radiator as air is pulled across it's cooling fins by the electric fan.

How to Troubleshoot Overheating in a Ford Focus | It Still ...

P0128 is a relatively common OBDII trouble code. It is triggered when your Ford Focus 's coolant temperature fails to reach the proper operating temperature. It's a generic powertrain code, which means that regardless of who manufactured the vehicle, it'll have the same meaning (1996+).

On my brothers Focus fan starts at 139C and idling temp is 135-140C. When driving it gets down to 125C! The needle stays on 90C for the coolant but TEST MODE shows the real temp. of engine.

If I recall from my Scangauge, the temp gauge is at its normal mid-range point when the engine is in the 160-170 deg range. But the engine continues to warm up slowly to around 200 deg for many minutes after that with little to no gauge movement.
