While each instructor has his own criteria and specifications, the majority of reflection papers are no more than one to two pages in length. To write an effective and successful reflection, a student must start his paper with an introduction that eases the reader into the topic and briefly states what will be discussed via a thesis statement.

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A reflective essay incites the writer to reflect on topics from the framework of personal experience. Reflective essays must have a clearly defined focus with a consistent point of view. They should provide background information and include narrative elements such as plot, characters, setting and conflict.

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The introduction of a reflection essay should lead the reader to the disclosure of the topic, which, as a rule, is formulated in the form of a question or contains a quotation. All these topics suggest the reader's reflections on a certain problem, therefore in the introduction, it is important to show what caused the interest to this topic, its polemical nature, suggesting the presence of several points of view.
