Iser further elaborates his concept of the "implied reader" in The Act of Reading, in which he discusses the "real reader" (the actual reader whose response is documented in the text" and the "hypothetical reader" (who is a "projection of all possible realisation of the text").

In the United States Iser had a major impact on the field of literary studies with the publication of The Implied Reader (1972) and The Act of Reading (1978), a translation of Der Akt des Lesens (1976). It was in 1976 that Iser first came to UC Irvine, as a visiting Professor of German.
